NOTICE N-5
“Water Service Fees Tariff
for Montreal Port Authority Facilities”
Effective on February 1, 2012

1. Short Title

This Notice may be cited as the tariff of Water Service Fees.

2. Definitions

In this Notice,

- (1) “*Authority*” means the Montreal Port Authority as defined under Section 2 and Section 8 of Part I of the Canada Marine Act and letters patent issued on March 1, 1999;
- (2) “*harbour*” or “*Port of Montreal*” legal and physical designation of all real properties that the Montreal Port Authority manages, holds or occupies as set out in Appendix A entitled “Description of Navigable Waters” and Appendix B entitled “Description of Federal Real Property” of its Letters Patent issued on March 1, 1999, as stipulated in the Canada Marine Act;
- (3) “*owner*” designates the vessel owner, the ship agent, the charterer by demise or the master of a vessel;
- (4) “*unmetered fire line*” means a water line connected directly to facilities of the Authority solely for the purpose of fire protection; and
- (5) “*water service*” means water service provided by the Authority.

3. Fees

The standard water service fees are as set out in Schedule I.



4. Forfeiting Turn

Any vessel that is not ready to receive water at the time at which water was ordered shall forfeit its turn.

5. Notification

The customer requesting the water service:

- (i) shall notify the Authority of the date and time when the water service is to be discontinued;
- (ii) is liable for all charges incurred for the water until the service is discontinued.

- 6.** Water service shall be provided at such sections or areas of the harbour as the Authority may from time to time designate.

7. Interruption of Service

The Authority is not responsible for failure to supply or for any delay or interruption in supplying water or for any deficiency in the quality of water supplied.

8. Accrual and Payment of Fees

- (1) Water service fees are claimable upon rendering of the service.
- (2) All fees referred to in subsection (1) must be paid within 30 days of the date of invoice. Where charges are not paid within the said period, a compound interest of 1½% (18% per year) is payable monthly.
- (3) Water service fees prescribed by this notice are claimable from the owner of the vessel or the customer requesting the service.
- (4) Fees prescribed by this notice are in addition to any fees prescribed in any other notice, or that may be owing to the Authority.

8. Accrual and Payment of Fees (Cont'd)

- (5) Water service fees and interest rate are also payable by Her Majesty in right of Canada or a province.
- (6) Prescribed fees are payable to the Authority.

	(ii) Other vessels of less than 6,000 DWT and Great Lakes vessels (<i>Lakers</i>)
