

UPDATE ON THE PORT OF MONTREAL RAIL CAPACITY EXPANSION PROJECT

(JULY 2021)

Project works to increase rail freight capacity are underway on Port of Montreal territory between Alphonse D. Roy and Valois Streets (Sections 39 to 44, shown in yellow on the map).



Phase 1 (Sections 39 to 44): June to November 2021, Phase 2 (Sections 32 to 39): May to November 2022, Phase 3 (Sections 24 to 32): May to November 2023

Due to technical challenges encountered at the start of construction, piling work must be done differently. Mitigation measures are being considered and will be closely monitored.

Please note that the piling work will be completed in early August and will be done during the day, on weekdays. Phase 1 of this project is expected to be completed in November of this year and the work will be carried out mainly from Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. On rare occasions, work will be done on weekends.
